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### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Seattle City Light plans to replace aging electrical infrastructure in the SODO neighborhood. The work will include replacing aging utility poles, overhead wire and equipment to help upgrade the existing electrical system. **Please see the map on the back of this flier for more information.**

### PROJECT BENEFITS

- The project will replace aging electrical infrastructure and upgrade the existing electrical system.
- The electrical upgrades will reduce unplanned power outages.

### PROJECT IMPACTS

- Crews will begin replacing utility poles, overhead wire and equipment in the following areas:
  - 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue South
  - 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue South
  - South Massachusetts Street
  - Holgate Street
- Maintenance power outages are required to do the work safely. **Notification will be provided in advance of outages.** The notification will specify the date, time and duration of the outage.
- Crews will reduce traffic and parking impacts by working one area at a time. However, traffic will be restricted and "No Park" signs enforced in work zones. "No Park" signs will be removed once work has been completed.
- The new poles will be placed alongside pre-existing poles. Pre-existing poles will be removed once the transfer of all utilities is done by other utilities. Seattle City Light will monitor these efforts to facilitate the removal of old poles.



Construction is tentative to start in early to mid-June 2017.
